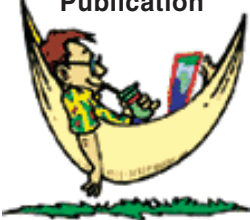

That's right the **2nd Annual Tybee Island Pirate Fest** weekend is here and that means lots of pirates, merriment, parades, partying and much more - all with free admission.

According to legend, for many decades pirates roamed the coast of Georgia and the Savannah River. The pirates came to Tybee to bury their treasures and replenish their supplies, supposedly an untold fortune in treasure is buried somewhere along the Georgia coast; though that treasure has never been discovered. Now, the "last of the buccaneers" that terrorized the coastal waters of Georgia during the late 18th and early 19th



century have gathered together to carry on their legacy.
